

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective December 16, 2021, the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) is the most significant update to the Federal Lead and Copper Rule in the last 30 years. This notification seeks to build your awareness on these regulatory requirements, and how MAWA will continue to protect public health while ensuring regulatory compliance. MAWA will be responsible for complying with the below requirements by October 16, 2024:

	<p>Lead Service Line Inventory - documenting the materials of and reporting to PA DEP the utility-owned and privately-owned portion of the service line supplying drinking water to each address in their service distribution area.</p>
	<p>Sampling - prioritizing the collection of water quality samples from addresses in their service distribution area that have known lead service lines, galvanized requiring replacement lines, or copper service lines with lead solder.</p>
	<p>Customer Communications - sending annual notification to addresses in their service distribution area that have known lead lines, galvanized requiring replacement lines, or lines with an unknown material.</p>
	<p>Lead Service Lines Identification - identifying known lead or galvanized service lines, requiring replacement, and lines with an unknown material.</p>
	<p>School & Facility Testing - collecting water quality samples from all elementary schools and child care facilities in their service distribution area between 2025-2029.</p>

To help MAWA continue to protect public health while ensuring regulatory compliance, MAWA seeks your participation in a survey of the privately-owned portion of the service line. Surveys will be distributed beginning July 2023, in the form of a post card. Customers can complete the survey on the post card and return it by mailing to 120Water or to MAWA via email, in person at our office, or online by utilizing the QR Code.
